The job will encompass all aspects of field and office activities in our Unionville, MO office. Work typically involves process checks or review of output by a co-worker or supervisor. These checks become less frequent as incumbent gains working knowledge, skills, abilities, and experience. The technician will be responsible for tasks including but not limited to:

- Manage compliance records and documentation for distribution and transmission pipeline operations
- Plans and manuals reviews, updates, and implementation
- Perform/Supervise tasks related to the installation, testing, & operation of natural gas facilities
- Manage processes and lead direct reports, subcontractors, and consultants to desired outcomes.
- Pipeline patrols and utility locating
- Management of One-Call Center locates and distribution of field personnel
- Interface with clients on a regular basis
- Understand, review, and comply with state and federal pipeline safety regulations
- Cathodic protection (CP) surveys and remedial action
- Leakage surveys and leak investigations utilizing standard industry equipment
- Odorization testing and reporting
- Inspections of mains and services
- Valve inspections and maintenance
- Regulator and relief valve installation, testing, and maintenance
- Maintain Operator Qualification (OQ) certification
